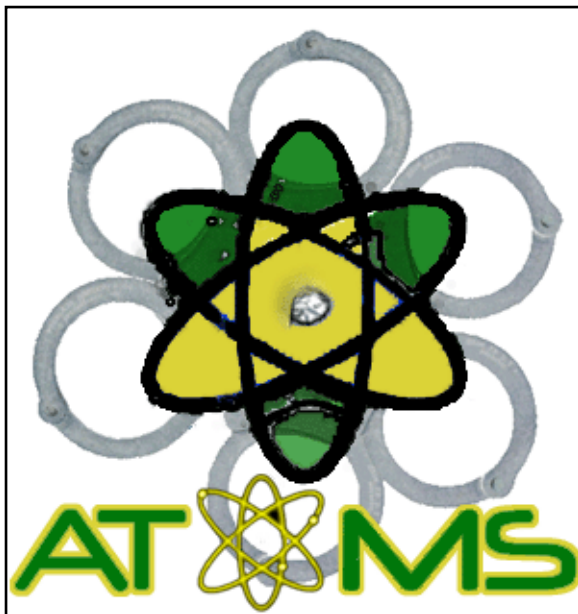




2009 Season Preview Series Vol. 1.1
